

Purpose of this Operating Procedure

1. This Operating Procedure defines the procedure for the election of members to the HPAC/ACVL Board of Directors (BoD)
 - a. in a general election
 - b. in a by-election

Procedure for the Election of Directors

2. The HPAC/ACVL Office shall normally act as election supervisor (Supervisor).
3. The Supervisor shall publish a call for candidates from those regions holding elections. The Supervisor shall specify 10 calendar days by which time submission of candidates' names shall be concluded. If no candidates come forth after the specified date the supervisor shall send out an additional notice allowing an additional 5 days for candidates from all regions to come forth and represent that region. All names received by that date shall constitute the candidates for election to the BoD.
4. Members may nominate themselves or be nominated by another member (in this case, the nominee must confirm that he/she accepts the nomination). Nominations need not be seconded.
5. Candidates shall submit a brief statement outlining their background in the sport and particular initiatives they would champion if elected to the BoD to the Supervisor to be shared with the membership of the region.
6. If there is only one candidate at the end of 10 calendar days for the submission of names, the Supervisor will run an election, providing exactly 10 calendar days, confirming a vote of confidence in favour of that candidate.
7. The election supervisor shall prepare an electronic ballot and disseminate it to the membership along with the date for the close of voting for the election.
8. HPAC/ACVL members in those regions holding elections shall be eligible to vote for one candidate representing his or her geographic region (as determined by the members address registered with HPAC/ACVL).
9. Votes in an election shall be cast by electronic means. Votes shall be counted only if received before the close of the voting period.
10. There shall be no proxy voting - members shall submit their own ballot.
11. With full transparency the Supervisor shall tabulate the vote, shall notify the HPAC/ACVL President, BoD and members of the region of the election result, and shall confirm that the election has been completed according to the required procedures.

Schedule for the Election of Directors

12. Election of members from the eight regions shall be alternated geographically:
- a. In even numbered years, Elections of Directors shall be held from the following provinces:
 - i. Atlantic Provinces
 - ii. British Columbia
 - iii. Ontario
 - iv. Prairie Region (Manitoba, Saskatchewan) and Nunavut
 - b. In odd numbered years, Elections of Directors shall be held from the following provinces:
 - i. Alberta and Northwest Territories
 - ii. Québec
 - iii. Yukon
